Cover band brings its *'beer for the ear'* to Morristown, NJ venues

Lunch Hour Six Pack ... a.k.a. LH6P ... a New Jersey- based, five-piece classic, alternative and modern rock cover band, will take the stage at several Morristown venues throughout the next couple of months. The band will celebrate its 75th show on Feb. 5 at The Famished Frog, followed by March 5 at Hennessey Washington Bar. Two band members, Jon Zayle and Mike Comiskey, will bring their acoustic side project, Lunch Hour Six Pack Light, to the Dublin Pub on Thursday and March 24.

The LH6P band members include Zayle, Mike Comiskey, Brian Comiskey, Rob Ussia and Dominic Musolino. The band, which has more than 100 collective years of music experience (and they're not that old!), first hit the club scene in 2008. According to Zayle, the name originated in 1995 during what he describes as "a less mature stage of his life."

In addition to bars and restaurants across New Jersey, the band plays numerous private and corporate events, including the New Jersey Chapter Road Dawg Motorcycle Club Picnic, CGI Racing New Jersey State Triathlon, CGI Racing Rutgers Unite Half Marathon, Greater Media Good Samaritan Holiday Bash and the Heineken USA Corporate Retreat.

With what the band describes as "beer for the ear," its eclectic set list includes Cheap Trick, Van Halen, Green Day, Pearl Jam, The Beatles, U2, Billy Joel, The Cars, Stone Temple Pilots, Foo Fighters, The Who, Smashing Pumpkins, Radiohead, Led Zeppelin and Jimi Hendrix. LH6P says their influences are diverse, ranging from progressive rock, blues, jazz, metal and funk.

Zayle started playing bass at age 12, learning the intro to Ozzy Osbourne's "Crazy Train." He has since played almost every genre of music in numerous original and cover bands for more than 20 years and has provided bass lines for three original projects before bringing the boys together to form LH6P in September 2007. Mike Comiskey, lead guitarist and vocalist, has been playing guitar since he was 10 and has been a constant in the New Jersey music scene, winning New Jersey-based rock-influenced radio station WDHA's guitar competition in 2008. Mike's cousin, Brian, plays rhythm guitar and provides part-time lead vocals. Drummer Rob Ussia also provides lead and backing vocals. Dominic Musolino, the lead vocalist, has been singing and playing guitar in heavy metal and rock bands since he was 15.

"The audience can expect an enthusiastic group of guys playing songs you'll know, songs you haven't heard in a while and unique arrangements you won't expect to hear ... but we think you'll enjoy them all," Zayle said.

It would seem Zayle takes his interest in beer almost as seriously as his interest in music. Zayle, a "huge craft beer fan," contributes to a website called Beer Nexus (www.beernexus.com), which features everything beer-related, including award-winning articles by beer connoisseurs, reviews by certified tasters, a beer festival calendar of events and original beer cooking recipes.
